HISTORICAL NOTE

Milligan co-founder Sara Eleanor LaRue Hopwood coined the phrase “Christian Education, the Hope of the World.” In 1888 this phrase replaced “Age Quid Agis” as the motto of Milligan College. “Christian Education, the Hope of the World” remained Milligan’s motto until 2001, when “Changing Lives, Shaping Culture” was adopted.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This artifact is the banner placed on the pulpit in Seeger Chapel during Matriculation, Commencement, and other major events. It bears the “Christian Education, Hope of the World” motto.
